Application Information

Please read this important information in its entirety.

Prerequisite:

No person shall be qualified to apply to be considered for Board appointment as a full Director-Youth to the Board unless he or she is an **active** 4-H member in good standing, and be at least eighteen (18) and not more than twenty-one (21) years of age at the time of his or her appointment by the Board of Directors.

Duration:

The length of term (appointment) will be one year which will expire at the completion of the Annual General Meeting, not exceeding three consecutive terms (at the discretion of the Board) and/or be re-appointed to the office of Director-Youth if over 21 years of age (whichever is first).

Commitment:

The board meets 5 times per year (i.e. April, July, October and December 2010 and February 2011). There are committees you could be appointed to or volunteer to serve on, as well as the opportunity to represent the Ontario 4-H Council at external or member events.

Location:

Locations of meetings vary across the province. Travel, food and accommodations are covered by the Board. There is no honorarium or per diem paid for being a Director on the Board.

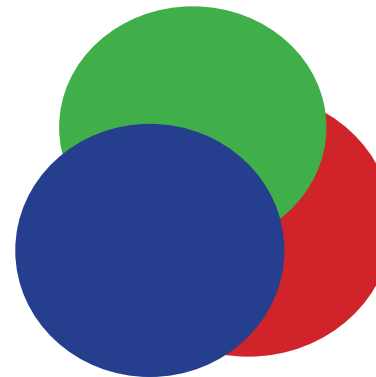
Application Process:

The Board of Directors of the Ontario 4-H Council is seeking applications for the position of Director-Youth on the Board. This is a full Director position that is filled at the Board's discretion. The responsibilities of this position are the same as all other Director positions on the Board. The unique requirements are the need to be an active 4-H member and fall within the age requirements as stated above. If you have a passion for the 4-H program, and a commitment toward learning board processes and policies – then apply today to be considered for this important role.
